**ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES**

The Court finds that notice of proposed amendments to the local rules of this court was given to the bar and public on February 28, 2005. This notice set March 31, 2005, as the last date for comments concerning the proposed amendments to be submitted to the court. The Court, having considered all comments received, ORDERS that, effective immediately, the local rules of this court are amended as follows:

1. Paragraph (a) of N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-2002-2 is amended by the addition of a new subparagraph (24) which reads as follows:

(24) Applications to employ professionals *nunc pro tunc*.

2. N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-5005-1 is amended to read as follows:

Effective July 1, 2005, any attorney who files any document or appears in more than five (5) cases in a calendar year, regardless of when the case was originally commenced, shall file all documents electronically through the court's ECF system. The failure to do so may result in the noncomplying document being stricken and/or the imposition of other appropriate sanctions. For purposes of this rule, the calendar year will begin on January 1 of each year.

3. Paragraph (a) of N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9014-2 is deleted. The designation of the remaining paragraph as paragraph (b) is deleted.
