GENERAL ORDER 95-1

MISCELLANEOUS FEE SCHEDULE

Whereas the Judiciary Appropriations Act of 1991 (Pub.L. 101-515, Title IV, §404, November 5, 1990) provided that the Judicial Conference of the United States shall prescribe and collect reasonable court fees for public access to federal court information available in electronic form, and

Whereas in March 1990, the Judicial Conference had approved amendments to the miscellaneous fee schedules for the district and bankruptcy courts to include yearly subscription rates and per minute usage charges for electronic access to court data, and

Whereas the Judicial Conference at its March 14, 1995, session provided, in Appendix II of the Bankruptcy Court Fee Schedule, that in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information that the court may exempt persons or classes of persons from the fee. And so

IT IS NOW ORDERED that for the public benefit PACER terminals if located in the public areas of the United States Bankruptcy Court Clerk's office at Gary, Fort Wayne and South Bend, as well as the PACER terminal if located in the public area of the United States District Court Clerk's office at Lafayette, are hereby exempt from the per minute usage fee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information PACER service provided to all individual case trustees, standing trustees and panel trustee members is hereby exempt from the per minute usage fee.
