ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

Notice of proposed amendments to Local Bankruptcy Rules B-2002-2, Notice of Opportunity to Object to Motions, and B-6004-1, Sales Outside the Ordinary Course of Business, was given to the bar and the public on June 6, 2012. The last date for submitting comments concerning the proposed amendments was July 6, 2012, and the court has not received any comments. Effective immediately:

1. Paragraph (a)(16) of Local Bankruptcy Rule B-2002-2, Notice of Opportunity to Object to Motions, is amended to read as follows.

“(16) Motions to sell property free and clear of liens and/or to distribute the proceeds of sale, except motions to sell or lease personally identifiable information.”

2. Paragraph (d) of Local Bankruptcy Rule B-6004-1, Sales Outside the Ordinary Course of Business, is amended to read as follows.

“(d) The proceeds of the sale shall not be disbursed, except pursuant to court order following an appropriate motion upon notice to all creditors and parties in interest, in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule B-2002-2.”
